Cosmetic Surgery Center of North Carolina is Chosen as National Training Center for BOTOX® Treatment

The Cosmetic Surgery Center of North Carolina has been chosen by Allergan, Inc., the manufacturer of Botox®, as a national training center to instruct physicians how to administer Botox® for frown lines treatment.

After having undergone three phases of investigation, Allergan reached approval by the Food and Drug Administration for the treatment of frown lines with Botox®. The FDA approval announcement for this indication occurred April 15, 2002. In preparation for the announcement, Allergan chose a few select, experienced physician practices throughout the nation to serve as training centers to teach physicians how to treat patients for frown lines with Botox®.

Botox Results



Drs. Charlie Finn and Sue Ellen Cox are two of the most experienced Botox® users in North Carolina. They have been using Botox® for cosmetic indications for several years. Dr. Cox and Finn were selected to participate in a physician training video for BOTOX® treatment and have been a study center for Botox® patient satisfaction studies. "We're very excited about the FDA finally approving BOTOX® for cosmetic use," states

Dr. Finn. "We hope that this is the first of many new Botox® indications in the cosmetic field." Allergan will next seek FDA approval for the use of Botox® for "crow's feet" around the eyes. Drs. Cox and Finn will begin the next FDA approval studies for the "crow's feet" indication this spring.

BOTOX® is the brand name for a naturally occurring protein that can relax hyperactive muscles. It has been used throughout the world for over 10 years

in thousands of patients to reduce or eliminate involuntary muscle contractions and spasms. Given by placing small injections of the agent into the muscle, BOTOX® has also been FDA approved to treat blepharospasm, strabismus and cervical dystonia.

The actual treatment takes only a few minutes and the Botox® takes effect in four to ten days. Gradually over three to five months the Botox® effect will fade and the muscle action will return. When the frown line starts to reappear, a simple repeat treatment is all that is necessary to maintain the desired results. Repeated treatments may act better than earlier treatments.

Botox® has also been found to be beneficial for patients who have a problem with

increased sweating. This has been found to be an extremely safe and effective treatment to stop sweating in the palms and underarms for as long as six to twelve months in some patients. The Cosmetic Surgery Center of North Carolina has been selected as one of the first sites to offer the FDA-approved XTRAC Excimer laser. The XTRAC laser allows us to offer patients a new alternative to the conventional approaches for treating psoriasis, vitiligo and hypopigmented scars. This laser is also under investigation for treatment of hypopigmented stretch marks and may be useful for hypopigmentation secondary to eczema or topical steroid use. We are very excited about being one of the first physicians' offices to make this cutting-edge treatment available in our area.

Patients with mild to moderate psoriasis and vitiligo are good candidates for the XTRAC laser. Psoriasis results from an overproduction of skin cells leading to thickening of the skin and scaling. Silvery skin plaques most frequently occur on the

scalp, elbows, knees and lower back. Vitiligo is a condition in which pigment cells are destroyed, resulting in irregularly shaped white

fiber-optic device, the XTRAC delivers high-exposure doses to site-specific psoriatic skin plaques and vitiligo skin

be treated effectively. The treatment sessions take about 5-10 minutes. Relief may be seen in just 4-10 quick sessions, 2 sessions per week. Patients will stay free of psoriasis and vitiligo outbreaks usually for several months. A few treatments per year will be necessary to remain free of symptoms.

Although this is a brand-new procedure without even an official procedure code, we have filed psoriasis XTRAC treatment sessions with some patients' insurance to attempt

reimbursement. We have been reimbursed for the XTRAC laser by some insurance companies for psoriasis. Please visit us to see if you are a good candidate for the XTRAC laser.

Fitzpatrick, associate clinical professor, University of California, San Diego, presents his clinical research studies on topical growth factors. Dr. Fitzpatrick is the founder of SkinMedica, a dermatologist-developed skin care product line. We carry SkinMedica's TNS Recovery Complex (Tissue Nutrient Solution).

TNS Recovery Complex contains naturally found proteins, amino acids and antioxidants to stimulate photodamaged skin to repair itself. Studies have shown that the growth factors stimulated a 37 percent increase in collagen and a 30 percent thickening of epidermis. Over half the patients in the clinical study had wrinkling improvement, and almost all had skin texture

"Growth factors apparently have a different mechanism from vitamins A and C for increasing collagen. Patients Beware: Key Messages Regarding Patient Complications Resulting From Non-Physician Services

The American Society for Dermatologic Surgery (ASDS) has launched a patient safety, consumer awareness campaign due to an alarming increase in patient complications resulting from services performed by non-physicians. It is vital that patients research their desired cosmetic services to find out if the person performing this service has the best credentials. The ASDS does believe that under appropriate circumstances and in accord with state regulations physicians may delegate certain procedures to licensed non-physician personnel, but the physician must be immediately available on-site to respond promptly to any problems or queries.

Complications patients suffered resulting from services performed by non-

physicians included burns, blotching, irreversible pigmentation and scarring. The services performed by non-physicians were laser/light-based hair removal, microdermabrasion, chemical peels, injectable filling agents, and light-based skin rejuvenation treatments. Non-physicians are not trained to diagnose skin disease and conditions and should not treat skin disorders without direct medical supervision.

Regulatory laws on the use of lasers by non-physicians are often vague and vary from state to state. Currently, only 15 states require a physician to operate a laser, while seventeen states allow physicians to delegate laser use to trained non-physician personnel. The amount of physician supervision required also varies greatly. Besides new

Florida laws, there are virtually no laws requiring physicians or non-physicians to report complications.

The past ASDS President, Dr. Harold J. Brody, announced the Patient Awareness Campaign after a member survey revealed a dramatic increase in patients seeking corrective treatment for complications. The Society is very concerned that patients know that cosmetic skin treatments using lasers and light devices, chemical peels, filling agents, Botox Injections, and microdermabrasion are surgical procedures carrying potentially serious side effects. These procedures offered at spas, salons and walk-in clinics should only be performed by physicians or under direct physician supervision. At the annual American Medical Association's meeting held in

December 2001, Board of Trustees Report 13, Business Practices of Aestheticians was presented. It asked the AMA to seek legislation restricting salons or spas that do not have a supervising physician from advertising that they can treat skin disease. The Board also wants to require those salons or spas that do have physician supervision to advertise his or her name.

The Cosmetic Surgery Center of North Carolina performs regular certification and compliance tests for all personnel who operate lasers and perform chemical peels and microdermabrasion. Our clinical staff are licensed, certified and reviewed annually. Dr. Sue Ellen Cox and Dr. Charlie Finn administer Botox Injections and filling agents themselves. Inquire within for credentials.

Medical News

In February, the FDA approved the *Candela diode laser for the treatment of periorbital (around the eyes) wrinkles*. The Vbeam non-ablative laser treatment is more comfortable for the patient because fewer pulses are necessary to cover the entire treatment area. The non-ablative laser procedure provides a healthier appearance by achieving a reversal of photoaging, better skin tone, smoother surface texture and fine wrinkle reduction. The Vbeam has put the treatment of periorbital wrinkles in the "lunchtime treatment" category, with little downtime for the patient. Patients must understand that no "down time" means slower results, fewer side effects, and multiple treatments. The advantages are a decreased risk and that normal activities may be resumed immediately. The disadvantage is that it may take longer to achieve the desired results.

We are currently offering the *Active Lifestyle Facial Rejuvenation* package! This intensive, non-invasive procedure package consists of Vbeam laser treatments, microdermabrasions and Precision peels, and the TNS Recovery cream, a skin bleaching product, and SkinCeuticals sunscreen. By combining these services in the *Active Lifestyle Facial Rejuvenation* package, our patients will get the best results from these procedures and products rather than receiving only a single service. The package is offered in a 2- and 4-month cycle. Botox can

be added for wrinkle treatment.

We have found that *BetaLift chemical peels work great on the rough bumps on the upper, back of the arms*, a condition called keratosis pilaris. We are offering Beta Lift peels for \$100.00; smooth your arms for your summer blouses!

We have a new policy that *patients being treated for Acne must be seen by the physician every four months*. We must monitor the prescribed medications and make sure they are working appropriately for the best care of our patients.

We now have an *in-office Skin Scanner* which shows sun-damaged areas using an ultra-violet light. This is a great tool for evaluating the extent of photodamage and choosing the best treatments, such as microdermabrasion, chemical peel, alpha hydroxy acids, tretinoin creams (Retin A/ Renova), and/or laser resurfacing.

We participated in the *"Relay for Life"* race in April, sponsored by the American Cancer Society. We brought our Skin Scanner and skin cancer literature to the event to help make the public more aware of the dangers of unprotected sun exposure.

We are now carrying many more M.D. Forte skin care products! So many patients have requested these items and we are very pleased to be able to offer them. Please check our skin care product

card for which products may be best for your type of skin.

Collagen users must be skin-tested if you haven't had collagen in over a year. Also, Collagen Corporation now requires two skin tests prior to administering collagen: *the second collagen skin test is given four weeks after the first skin test, then the patient must wait two more weeks to make sure there is no allergic reaction*.

Dermalogen, a human-tissue derived facial filling agent, is no longer being produced. Patients who have been using Dermalogen may enjoy comparable results from other filling agents such as Collagen, Cymetra, or Fat microtransfer treatments.

Again this year, the Cosmetic Surgery Center contributed to the annual Heart Gala, which raises funds for heart disease research.

Our Office Insurance Policies

Patients: Stay Informed!

It is very important that patients know their own current benefits, deductibles and co-payments. If a referral is required from your primary care physician, please obtain a referral prior to services rendered or you may be stuck paying out-of-pocket. Our office holds contracts with the insurance carriers posted at the front desk. Please call our office if you have a question about whether we accept your insurance.

We are now a participating provider with Blue Cross Blue Shield! Most plans have a deductible and co-payment. Please check your insurance card for benefits.

We have experienced many problems with Vbeam Laser coverage for birthmarks, rosacea, and other skin conditions. Insurance companies have been inconsistent with their claims processing, paying some treatments and then denying subsequent sessions, deeming the treatments as medically unnecessary. On an individual basis, we have filed appeals documenting medical necessity. *Due to the overwhelming number of rejections and appeals, we now require that the patient pay for Vbeam Laser treatments at the time of service.* We will file a claim for you and reimburse you after the insurance company pays. However if you're your insurance company has been reimbursing consistently, we will continue to file your Vbeam laser treatment claims for you.

Another procedure that we perform, the Xtrac Laser for psoriasis and vitiligo, must be paid for at the time of service by the patient. This is a new procedure that is also processed differently by each insurance company. We submit documentation with each claim, however the insurance company does not always warrant Xtrac laser treatments as medically necessary.

Cigna members beware: if you have PrimaHealth, your benefits do not apply here! Please check your insurance card carefully. Cigna has now printed the PrimaHealth statement on the back of your cards if you have a primary care physician who participates with this Cigna

program. If you have an old insurance card, you must check with your primary care physician (PCP) to see if that provider is PrimaHealth. *We do not belong to the PrimaHealth product of Cigna and cannot file your insurance!*

Prior research of two particular procedures, Sclerotherapy (the treatment of leg veins) and Chemical Peels, shows that most insurance companies typically categorize these as cosmetic (not medically necessary). *Therefore, we do not file claims for Sclerotherapy or Chemical Peels.* We are willing to discuss this with you on an individual basis.

We will always be happy to discuss any statement you receive from us after your insurance benefits have been paid. *Call Rachel at 682-2901.* However, for benefits issues, please contact your carrier first.
